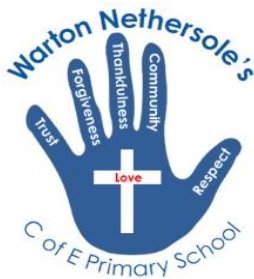
Dear Parents,

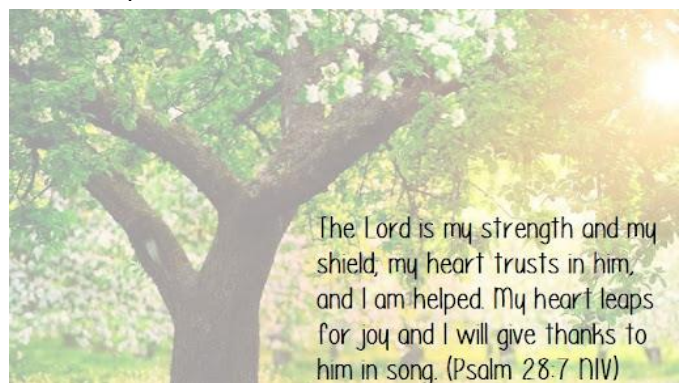
