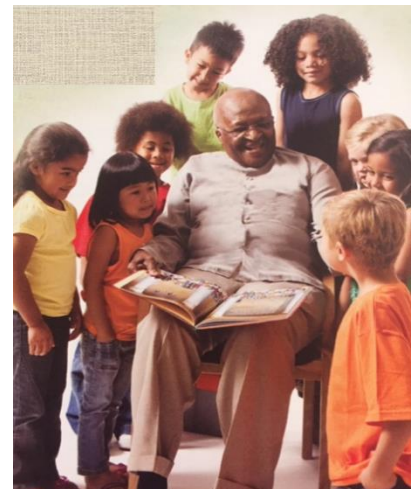

### Mrs Shigdar's Tips for Wellbeing!

Mrs. Shigdar, our family support worker, has been thinking of ways to support our children and our families at home. Each week she shares a tip with you all to try and think about. This week Mrs Shigdar talk to us about Bullying...



Bullying can happen to anyone at any time, to a child, young people or even adults. Bullying is an act of 'unwanted, aggressive attitude or behaviour that may be directed at a person's gender, sexuality, disability or lack of ability in a particular area, it could be based on the person's religion or culture. This attitude or behaviour is then repeated again and again.'

Now, we know within a school setting it is natural for children to speak openly and honestly when sharing their thoughts and opinions on things. These can at times, but hurtful when on the receiving end. Thankfully all the adults here at school are well skilled in explaining this to those involved, helping them to understand and reason why they may have unwillingly upset someone. These types of incidents are not classed as bullying, as they are not done with the intent or aggressive attitude to hurt.

The difference between this type of situation and a bullying scenario, is the ' imbalance of power that the bully has over the victim'. A bully may use their physical power or body height and build to intimidate or embarrass others, to have control over someone. They may make threats, spread rumours, lash out physically or verbally or ignore someone by not letting them join in a group or game on a daily basis. The behaviour or attitude is repeated over time, it is not just a one-time comment or action.

As a school we take any incident of bullying, no matter how big or small, very seriously. We take the time to listen to those involved and will investigate further to determine all the facts. All school staff will endeavour to make sure any victim of bullying feels safe and reassured and that action will be taken to stop this type of behaviour. Staff will make sure any victim is happy to return to their normal school routine with the feeling of being safe, secure and looked after. They will be monitored and checked on by school staff so this feeling continues. The bully will also be spoken with, to try and understand what is behind their actions, but importantly informed how their behaviour has made others in school feel. Work will be done with them so they can understand why this is not acceptable behaviour. Sanctions will be given if it is felt necessary and parents informed. All bullying incidents are recorded within school and Miss. Friend is made aware.

## School applications 2022/2023

The 15 January deadline for school applications for children due to start school in Reception in September 2022 is fast approaching.

This applies to children born between 1 September 2017 and 31 August 2018 for Reception.

All applications received by the deadline will receive a school offer on 19 April, which is National Offer Day.

Any applications submitted after the 15 January will be much less likely to be offered a place at a preferred school.

Applications should be made online on the Warwickshire County Council website where parents and carers can also find useful information on school transport, priority school areas and admissions criteria.

Any prospective Reception parents can get in touch with the school office to arrange to speak with our EYFS Lead and/or a covid-safe visit.

## New Isolation Rules

From Monday 17 January, people who are self-isolating with COVID-19 will have the option to reduce their isolation period after 5 full days if they test negative with a lateral flow device (LFD) test on both day 5 and day 6 and they do not have a temperature. For example, if they test negative on the morning of day 5 and the morning of day 6, they can return to their education or childcare setting immediately on day 6.

The first test must be taken no earlier than day 5 of the self-isolation period, and the second must be taken the following day. All test results should be reported to NHS Test and Trace.

If the result of either of their tests is positive, they should continue to self-isolate until they get negative results from two LFD tests on consecutive days or until they have completed 10 full days of self-isolation, whichever is earliest.

Anyone who is unable to take LFD tests or anyone who continues to have a temperature will need to complete the full 10-day period of self-isolation.

## PE days

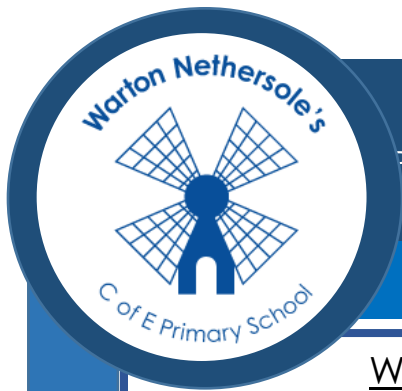
Please note there are some changes to our PE days this term please, remember to send your child to school in their PE kit on PE days.

In line with our Covid risk assessment we will be keeping windows and doors open throughout the term for ventilation as this is part of the government guidance to help prevent the spread of Covid. If children own a school fleece, body warmer or extra layers and wish to wear these in class to keep warm throughout the winter they may do so.
