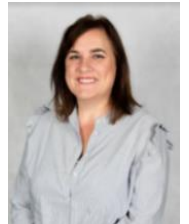

### Mrs Shigdar's Tips for Wellbeing!

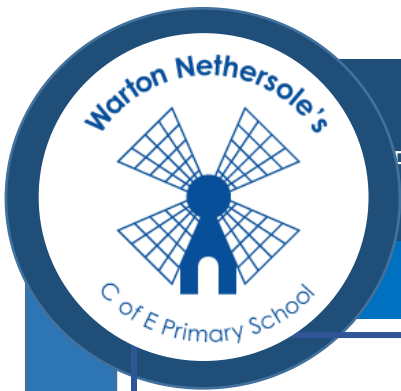


Did you know that Warwickshire offer a number of FREE opportunities for parents to get together to openly discuss, learn and share parenting tips and advice. As we all know children do not come with an instruction manual and just because something worked with one child does not mean it will work with the next child. They are all wired differently, so will behave, react, explore and have different reasoning to each other. One of the best things about these meet-up's, is the chance to meet other parents who have or are going through the same or similar experiences to you. The sense of knowing you are not alone is such a relief and a morale booster. It is a chance to laugh, cry, share your stories or advice on how you managed, offer support and encouragement from one parent to another, as well as hear what solutions the professionals have. This may be something you have never heard off before or even be aware of.

The courses on offer range from pregnancy, birth and through the different stages of development of children. They cover topics like understanding your children and their mental health, reading their feelings, behave and emotions, how their brains work and changes in adolescence to relationship building and self-regulation.

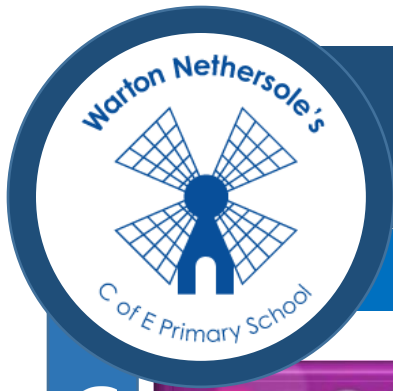
