We can't wait to welcome you to this event and thank you in advance for practicing those lines and songs at home!

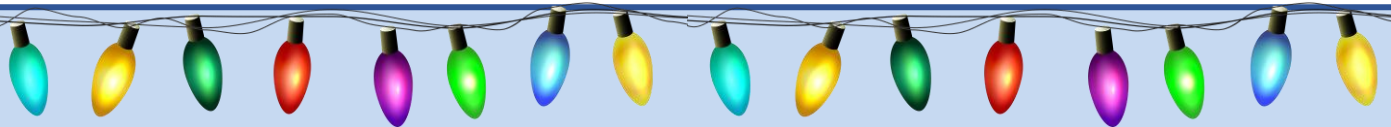
