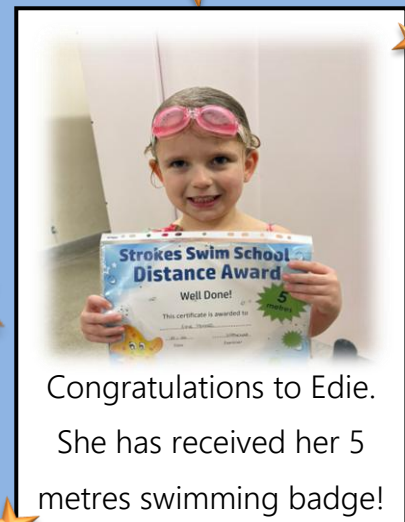


No Office Access!
