Dear Parents,



I want to start with an ENORMOUS for all of your fundraising efforts at home as part of our Warton sponsored walk last Friday! It was a glorious morning and the sun shone for our walk around the farmers fields- although it was a little muddy! The children walked over ONE MILLION steps between them and truly earned every penny they raised for our school.

All of our children, families and communities have tried exceptionally hard to fundraise and we were truly touched and shocked by the amounts of money families were bringing in! Every penny really counted and I am so proud to reveal that we have raised **£2300!!!** 90% of the fundraising will go towards playground games and equipment while 10% will go to our partner school in Kimillili, Kenya. Thank you all so much!

This week, I have also been really proud of the children – particularly those in Willow, Sycamore and Beech who have all performed to their parents. Mrs Sage was hugely positive about Beech Class and their poem on Wednesday and yesterday, I was delighted to see Sycamore's poem and Willow's prayer be read so loudly and beautifully! Thank you to all of the parents who supported and attended these sessions – we love having you in school and it means so much to the children to see you in their audience!

I hope that you all have a wonderful, sunny (fingers crossed!) and family filled Easter break and wish you all a very happy Easter. I look forward to seeing you all back at school on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> April.
