Dear Parents,

How lovely it is to see the sunshine! Let's hope it's here to stay. We have had a really busy and enjoyable start to the summer term in school. It was wonderful to start our half-term with our Values Day last week. Our focus value this half-term is that of forgiveness. During values day we listened to the Bible story about Jesus forgiving Peter and thought about how important it is to forgive others when they do something unkind, but also recognised that this can be hard to do at times. Each class thought about the value of forgiveness from a different perspective; nursery thought about saying sorry, Willow thought about being compassionate towards others, Sycamore thought about times when it is hard to forgive, Beech considered the benefits of forgiving others, Maple thought about reasons why people forgive, Elm considered why it is important to forgive others and ourselves, Rowan linked forgiveness to justice and Oak considered how to forgive those who might be considered unforgiveable. Throughout this half-term we will continue to focus on this value and how it links to our behaviour policy in relation to restorative justice.

It was good to see so many parents in school on Monday and Wednesday for our parents' evening. Please remember that if you have a concern or worry about anything relating to your child and their progress, to send a message to their teacher on Tapestry. We will always get back to you but can't promise this will be the same day. I have enjoyed reading so many positive post-it notes that were written for our children- they love to read the notes you have left them, and it gives them encouragement to keep on doing their best!

We have a really busy summer term ahead of us so please make sure to check your emails, Tapestry updates and the newsletter regularly so that you know what's going on for your child each week.

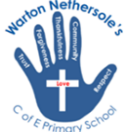
Values
