Dear Parents,

Unfortunately, we have had a number of wet playtimes and lunchtimes this week which has meant we haven't been able to get outside as much as usual. The last two weeks have been very important weeks for our Year 4 children and our Year 1 children as they have all completed the multiplication check and phonics screening respectively. Thank you to the parents of these children who have supported the pupils so well in making sure the children feel calm and relaxed, and to the staff in school who have ensured the children are ready for these assessments and feel confident to have a go! They all did brilliantly! Last week we welcomed Mr Bhatti from one of BDMAT schools to join Miss Ryan to ensure our Reception pupils are getting the very best start to school and to ensure all our Early Years assessments are accurate and consistent. It is always good to work with other BDMAT colleagues. Mr Bhatti really enjoyed his time with us and was very positive about everything he saw!

This is scheduled to take place on 29<sup>th</sup> June- in the morning all children will take part in individual running, jumping and throwing events and in the afternoon, children will be in house teams and compete in a carousel of activities to get as many points as possible for their house.
