We are finally enjoying some proper summer weather and I would like to take this opportunity to ask parents and carers support us promote sun safety in school over the coming weeks. Please make sure to apply sun cream before your child comes to school, send in a named sun cream (ideally a spray or roll on) that can stay in your child's classroom and please send a hat or cap to school with them every day along with a full water bottle. We will ensure that children who have sun cream in school apply it before going out at lunchtime. We will also make sure that water bottles are regularly topped up and that children have access to these as needed. We will endeavour to keep children in the shade as much as possible and will give children plenty of time to rest during social times and PE lessons.
